If our personal relationships are unsatisfactory, it is difficult to achieve our full potential, career goals or other personal goals.With so much at stake, it would seem reasonable that people would seek out expert guidance on how to develop, build and maintain good romantic relationships. In addition, we should seek to understand the underlying problems of poor relationships, signs to watch for, and know when and how to end a bad relationship. But Mr. Burton makes a very strong case that entering into romantic relationships without establishing clear roles, rules and expectations is setting yourself up for significant emotional distress. Mr. Burton takes a very logical, well thought out approach to romantic relationships. He examines all phases of romantic relationships and discusses in great detail the most successful ways to deal with the various issues that come up in personal relationships. The book is based on his extensive experience as a divorce attorney. He gives plenty of actual examples from his work dealing with couples in broken or badly damaged relationships. Mr. Burton discusses the underlying foundation of a relationship that will last: honesty, satisfaction and companionship. If both partners do not have compatible goals for the relationship, it is doomed to fail. That does not mean the people must think alike, but it does mean that their goals must be compatible. Mr. Burton writes in a conversational style with a tint of legalism scattered throughout the book. Mr. Burton is a lawyer and as such sees the world through the lens of his legal training. He adequately explains all legal terms and concepts he uses. There are a few type/formatting glitches but they are not excessive and do not really detract from the substance of the book. This book will be helpful for anyone involved in or likely to be in a romantic relationship. The approach is based on Mr. Burton's observations of thousands of couples he has worked with so there is some common recurring themes that seem to show up in relationships that don't work. An ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure. It is easy to think that your love is so strong it will overcome all problems. Unfortunately, the love often fades and you will find yourself needing the services of someone like Mr. Burton.
