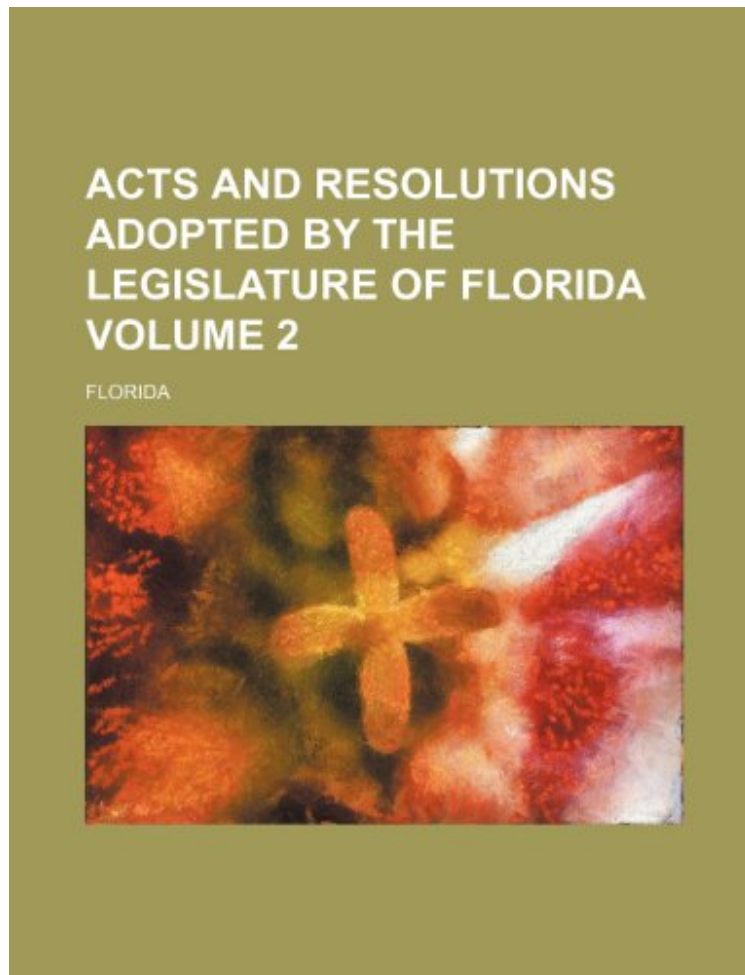

Sec. 13. On the day designated in the notice of sale, at 12 o'clock noon, the Tax Collector shall commence the sale of the lands on which taxes have not been

p-aid as aforesaid and shall continue the same from day to day until so much of each parcel thereof shall be sold, as is Chap-8942 necessary to pay said tax and costs. The Mayor of the 1921 town shall bid off for the town all parcels of land not otherwise bid for. Sec. 14. The Tax Collector shall require immediate payment by any person to whom any parcel of land may be struck off, except where the town is the purchaser, and in all cases where the payment is not made in twenty-four hours, he may declare the bid cancelled and sell the land again on the following day; and any person so neglecting or refusing to pay any bid made by him shall not be entitled after such neglect to have any bid made by him received by the Tax Collector during such sale. Sec. 15. At the sale aforesaid the Tax Collector shall Tax cortm, give the purchaser a certificate of such sale describing cate' the lands purchased and the amount paid therefor. The certificate shall be substantially in the following form: State of Florida, Town of Eatonville. Office of Tax Collector. No, A. D. 19... I, Tax Collector for the Town of Eatonville, in the County of Orange and State of Florida, do hereby testify that I did, at public auction, pursuant to notice given by law as required, on this, the.... day of.', A.
