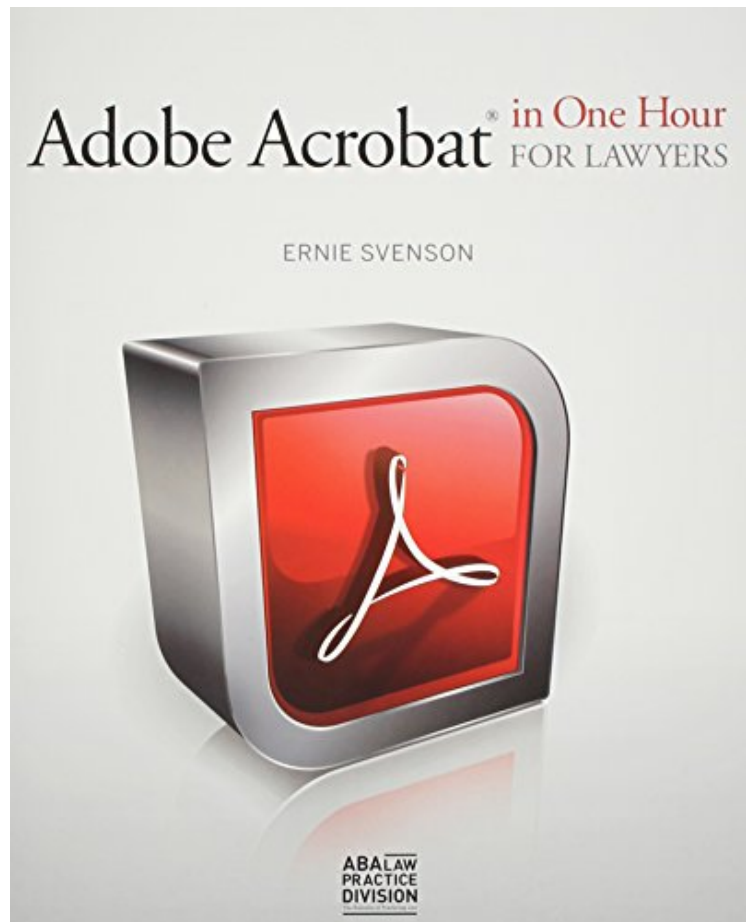

Ernie Svenson presents the fundamentals of PDFs and the accompanying program Acrobat in a very clearly written, well illustrated book full of screenshots to easily guide the reader in understanding and using the various features. He will quickly get you through the basics, and while any program can have 500 functions and commands, he'll show the basic ones that get the job done, and warn you of commands that don't.Aside from Ernie's clear and non-technical instructions, the layout of the pages are great. Large headers, readable 12 point type, short paragraphs and generous margins for penciling in your own notes.Aside from teaching basic tasks

in Acrobat, he goes into the different versions, Standard and Pro and does advise Pro for redacting and Bates numbering, both common in legal work. There are many other products like Acrobat, but first read this book and you will have a good idea what will best work for you. In the Appendix are recommendations for Acrobat Preferences and a table of shortcut keys and single key commands, and legal workflows. The lessons don't stop here. If you go to his website paperlesschase.com, you can keep current on developments since this book was printed. In short, this book is suited for legal and office work, and for anyone who would like to get started on the fundamentals of PDFs and Adobe Acrobat.
