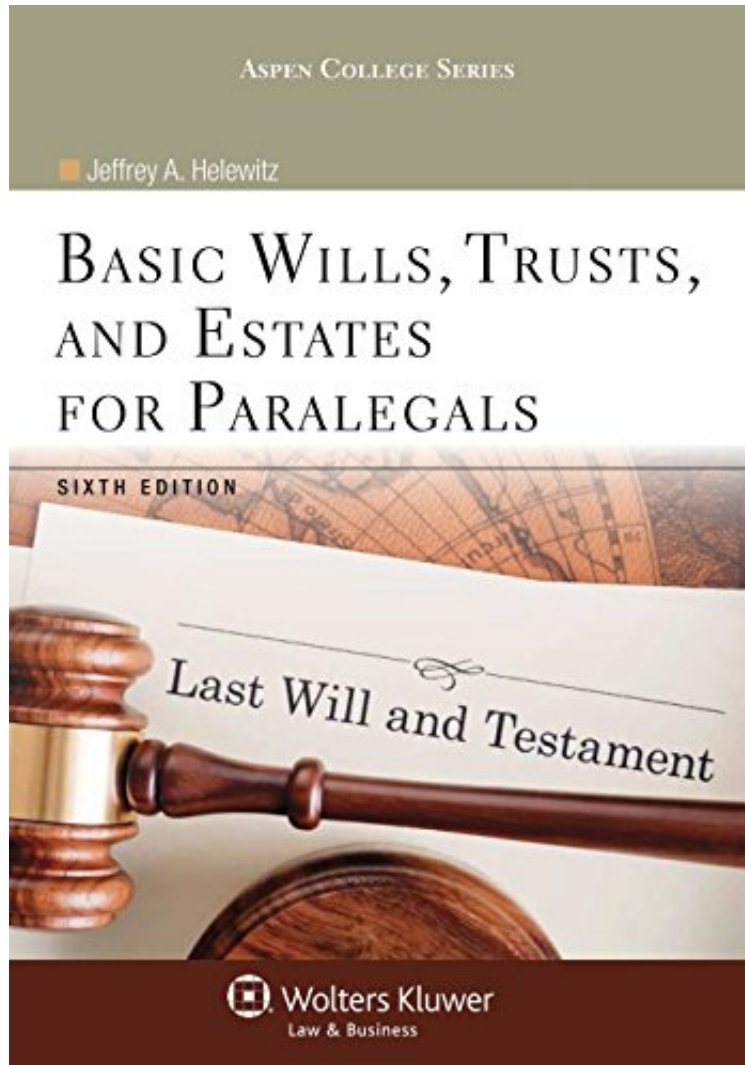

Helewitz is a well respected legal educator and textbook author, I found this particular textbook to oversimplify legal topics to the point that his definitions become inaccurate. In defining concepts in the simplest manner possible, he creates his own definitions for terms. Unfortunately, on occasion, his definitions are not consistent with legal authority and Black's Law Dictionary.I would not recommend this textbook.

Continuing examples describing four different families provide an accessible structure and helpful point of reference for students learning the intricacies of estate planning.
