The concept 'procreational responsibility,' which is introduced in the concluding chapter of the book, may be used as a tool to assess and reform existing regulations on legal parent-child relationships. The structure of the book, which is based on a categorization of different family types in a 'family tree,' enables the reader to have easy access to family-specific information.
