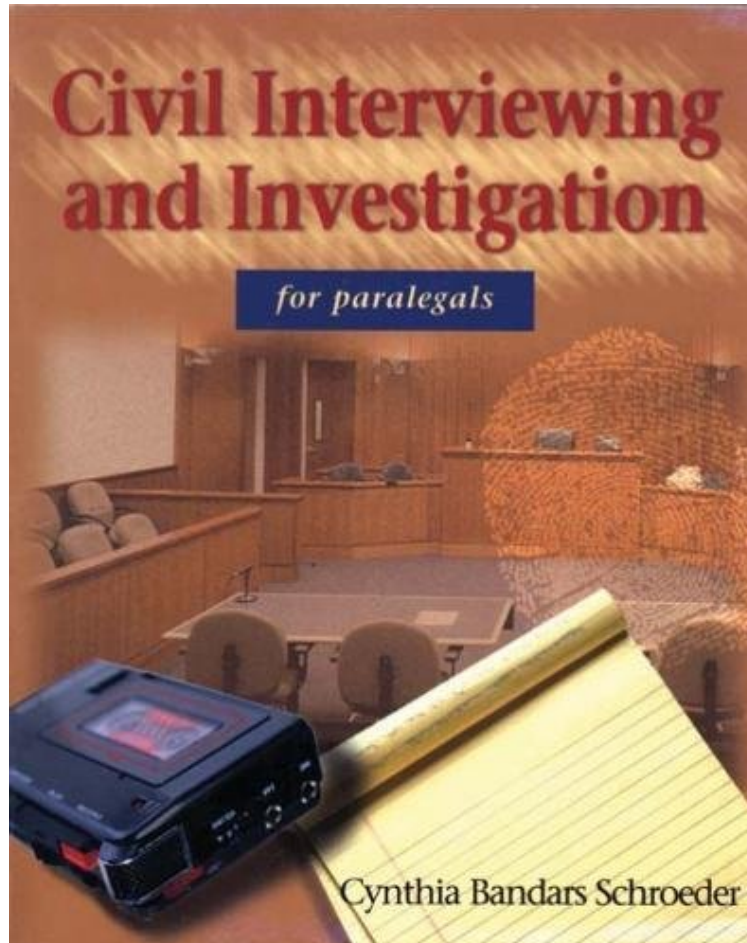

In fact, were I creating a curriculum for a paralegal studies program, I might include this as a text for an introductory course. However, the text is now outdated (the version I have was published in 1999; there are no updates to my knowledge). The links included are primarily obsolete, replaced by search engines that are faster, more popular, and more exact. The book also tends to repeat itself too frequently, restating theories and techniques in more than one chapter. Additionally, the case studies at the end of each chapter generally lack adequate information to complete properly. A student attempting to answer the questions for the case studies would provide better responses if s/he had a basic grasp of business, real estate, worker's compensation, or criminal law. However, the introductory nature of the book does not suggest that the student would have achieved that status in his/her education. It appears that textbooks covering the interviewing and investigation aspect of a paralegal's

career are few and far between (the only other textbook I've come across is Jodi McMaster's "Civil Interviewing and Investigating for Paralegals"). Despite this, I would not rely too heavily on this book were I a professor of law today. It is outdated and incomplete in scope; I would suggest attempting to take its best parts and use them in conjunction with other texts, lectures, or teaching materials. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
