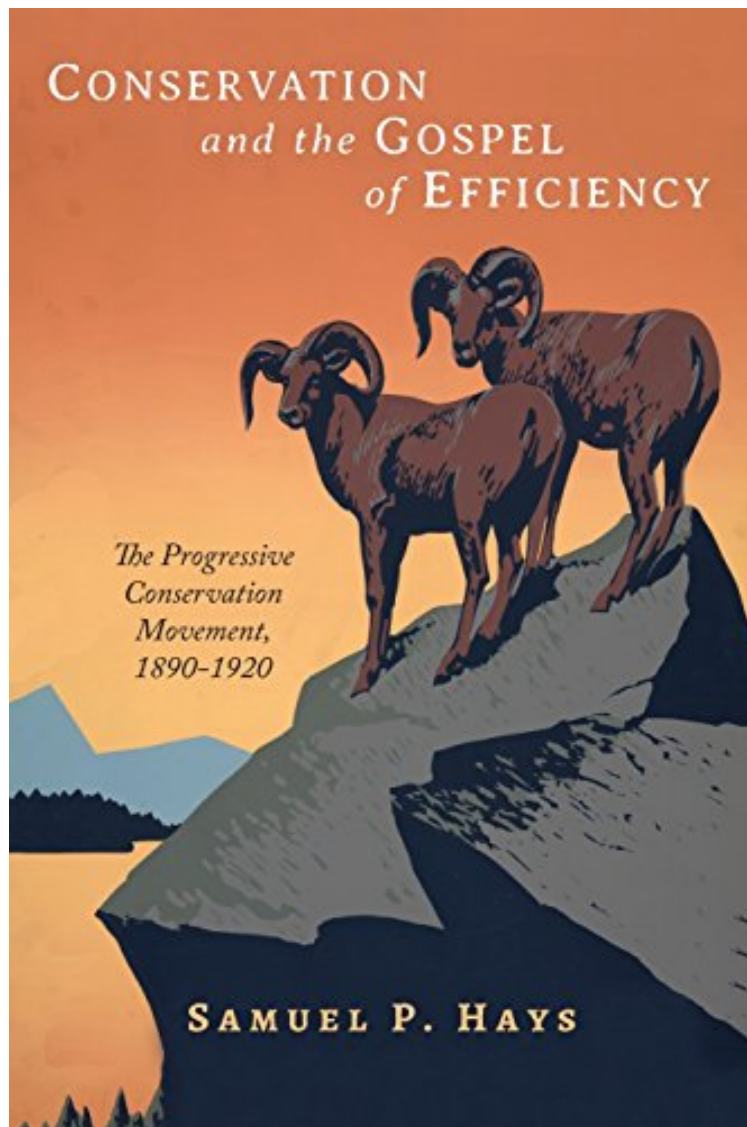

It's an excellent work that combines politics, power, Progressive Era philosophy, and conservation. The dates extend to 1920, but you'll probably find that it really ends around the time of Taft. There's not a lot of Wilson or his Secretary of the Interior, Frank Lane. The narrative largely focuses on Gifford Pinchot and his success or failure. Of particular interest is his struggle against Richard Ballinger, the Secretary of the Interior under Taft. Against a background of rivers, forests, ranges, and public lands, this book defines two conflicting political processes: the demand for an integrated, controlled development guided by an elite group of scientists and technicians and the demand for a looser system allowing grassroots impulses to have a voice through elected government representatives.
