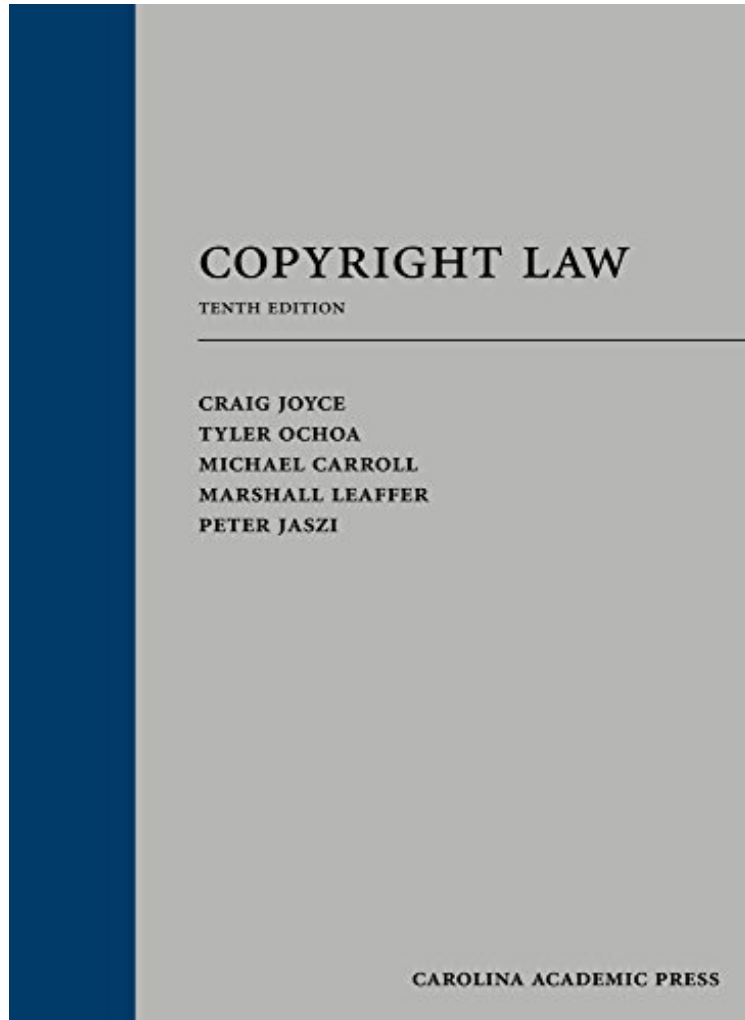

The Tenth Edition of Copyright Law features three new principal cases: the U.S. Supreme Court decisions in *Kirtsaeng v. John Wiley Sons* and *Aereo, Inc. v. American Broadcasting Cos.*, and the Second Circuit s decision in *Authors Guild v. Google, Inc.* (the "Google Books" case). It also features a reorganization of Chapter 2, bringing much

of *Feist Publications v. Rural Telephone Service Co.* forward, rather than deferring the full opinion to the end of Chapter 3, as in previous editions. The authors have also revised and updated the Notes and Questions throughout, to reflect the past three years of copyright case law.
